WHO REPORTS?

- Facilities are required by Federal statute to complete and file the 2011 Hazardous Waste if:
 - Met the definition of a RCRA Large Quantity Generator (LQG) during 2011; **or**
 - Treated, stored, or disposed of RCRA hazardous wastes on-site during 2011.
- Hazardous waste imported from a foreign country must be counted.
- Report your **current** Hazardous Waste Generator status as of the date of submitting your 2011 Hazardous Waste Report on the Site ID Form in Item 10.A.1

- Reports are due to the Division by March 1, 2012

The BRS Data Entry Program

The BRS data entry and display program (BRSW4) is a program for data entry and verification of the 2011 BIENNIAL HAZARDOUS WASTE REPORT in the EPA Electronic Reporting Guide format. This program will check, print, and format the flat file data for submission to EPA or your implementing State or Region. This self-expanding file (webBR2011.exe - 5.83MB) will expand into 15MB of Files on your hard drive (C:\BRS\ is the default).

Electronic submissions using the software below will generate this form by default. Please be careful to complete the 8700-12FL carefully and correctly in its entirety to reflect the CURRENT status of your facility. **Form OI is no longer required by the State of Florida.**

webBR2011.EXE	The BRS data program (BRSW4.EXE) is a program that will display the data submitted in the BIENNIAL HAZARDOUS WASTE REPORT in an easy to read Windows format and will allow data entry of a new report for submission to the State.
BRState Update	This file will update the BRState program without needing an administrator ONLY after the webBR2011.exe file has been installed at least one time on the PC you are using to complete the Biennial Hazardous Waste Report.
BRState Manual	This PDF document is the installation and operation manual for the BRS data program contained in webBR2011.EXE.

REQUIRED FORMS

- SI – Site Identification Form
 - **All fields required** – Complete – **Print, Sign, & Submit paper form**
 - Including those with public access (EnviroFacts, ECHO, etc.)
- GM – Generation and Management Forms
- WR – Waste Received Forms if the facility received waste from off-site
- OI – Off-site Identification (not required for Utah reporters)



REPORTS

- Enter data directly
- Loading/Importing data from company system
- Submit flat files
 - Meet required formatting, file specifications, & data quality
 - 2011 Electronic Specification Guide
- Report Submissions
 - Each data submission must contain **all** data for the site for which data is being submitted
