Proposed Action

In accordance with R315-4-1.6(c) the Executive Secretary of the Utah Solid and Hazardous Waste Control Board has prepared a Draft Modification Approval (draft approval) in response to a Class 3 Permit Modification Request to the Tooele Chemical Agent Disposal Facility (TOCDF) Part B Permit. The modification request is entitled, "Igloos 1632 and 1634 Permitted Container Storage." This permit modification seeks to add Igloos 1632 and 1634 to the TOCDF Part B Permit as permitted hazardous waste storage areas. The igloos are located in Area 10 at the Deseret Chemical Depot adjacent to the TOCDF facility.
