

SECURITY

The entire active portion of the facility shall be enclosed with a six-foot high chain link fence, topped with barbed wire. The fence layout is shown in Attachment II-1, Site Drawings. The fence line shall be maintained in good repair to prevent access underneath the fence that might develop due to erosion.

Gates shall be located strategically around the compound perimeter and kept locked when unattended or not observable by facility or contract personnel.

Lighting shall be located through key areas of the facility in order to facilitate inspection by facility personnel and safe processing.

The West Desert area in which the facility is located is sparsely populated, the nearest residence being approximately 35 miles from the facility. Access to the facility is from the south via a county road with access to Interstate 80. Approaching traffic is clearly visible to the security guards monitoring the access to the facility.

Signs with the words "DANGER-UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL KEEP OUT" shall be posted on the gates and the fence-line of the facility perimeter. The signs shall be in English and posted at intervals of no more than 120 feet. They shall be legible from a distance of at least 25 feet and shall be observable from any approach to the facility.
