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Waste Tire Transporter Registration Application

Pursuant to Utah Administrative Code R315-320-4, to obtain a waste tire transporter registration number and approval to act as a waste tire transporter, an applicant shall submit the following information on this form with accompanying required documentation to the Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste. Registration runs from January 1 to December 31 and must be renewed each year. Registration renewal applications must be received by December 15 of each year.
